Basic Requirements

- Minimum 600 words
- Printed submissions only, properly formatted

- Images included to illustrate points (do not cite)
- Written to a general audience

- Use any standard form of research citation (you choose)
- NO PLAGARISM
- Cite all online and print resources
- Include in-text citations
- Include works cited page

 - Laurie Schneider Adams, A History of Western Art (Chapters 13,14 are on Gothic Art)

Additional Sources

- Responses must include at least 2 additional legitimate resources
- These can include (but are not limited to) academic and general audience sources
- Online resources must use correct citation
- It can also include any reading handouts from this semester. (Cite with unit packet and page)

- Required Works
 - Response contains <u>discussion or direct references</u> to the following works.
 - Chartres Cathedral
 - Röttgen Pietà
 - The Golden Haggadah
 - Dedication Page with Blanche of Castile and King Louis IX of France and Scenes from the Apocalypse, from a *Bible moralisée*.

Additional Works

- Response contains discussion or references to <u>four</u> <u>additional works</u> from the Gothic style or any art-historic era. The works must come from the APAH 250
- Previous class discussion of additional works used is not necessary. Feel free to choose art or architecture we have not covered yet
